Growing in Faith: Class on Dietrich Bonhoeffer

Beginning November 2, join Pastor Curtis following morning worship services at 10:50 for classes studying the "Cost of Discipleship" by Dietrich Bonhoeffer. The book on this is available at a discounted cost of \$10. The 1st two Sunday's will be a video presentation on the life and times of Bonhoeffer, and the classes using the book will begin on November 23rd. Dietrich Bonhoeffer was a famous German Lutheran pastor, theologian, and resister of the Nazi regime. This is open to adults and senior high school students. See Pastor Curtis for questions.
