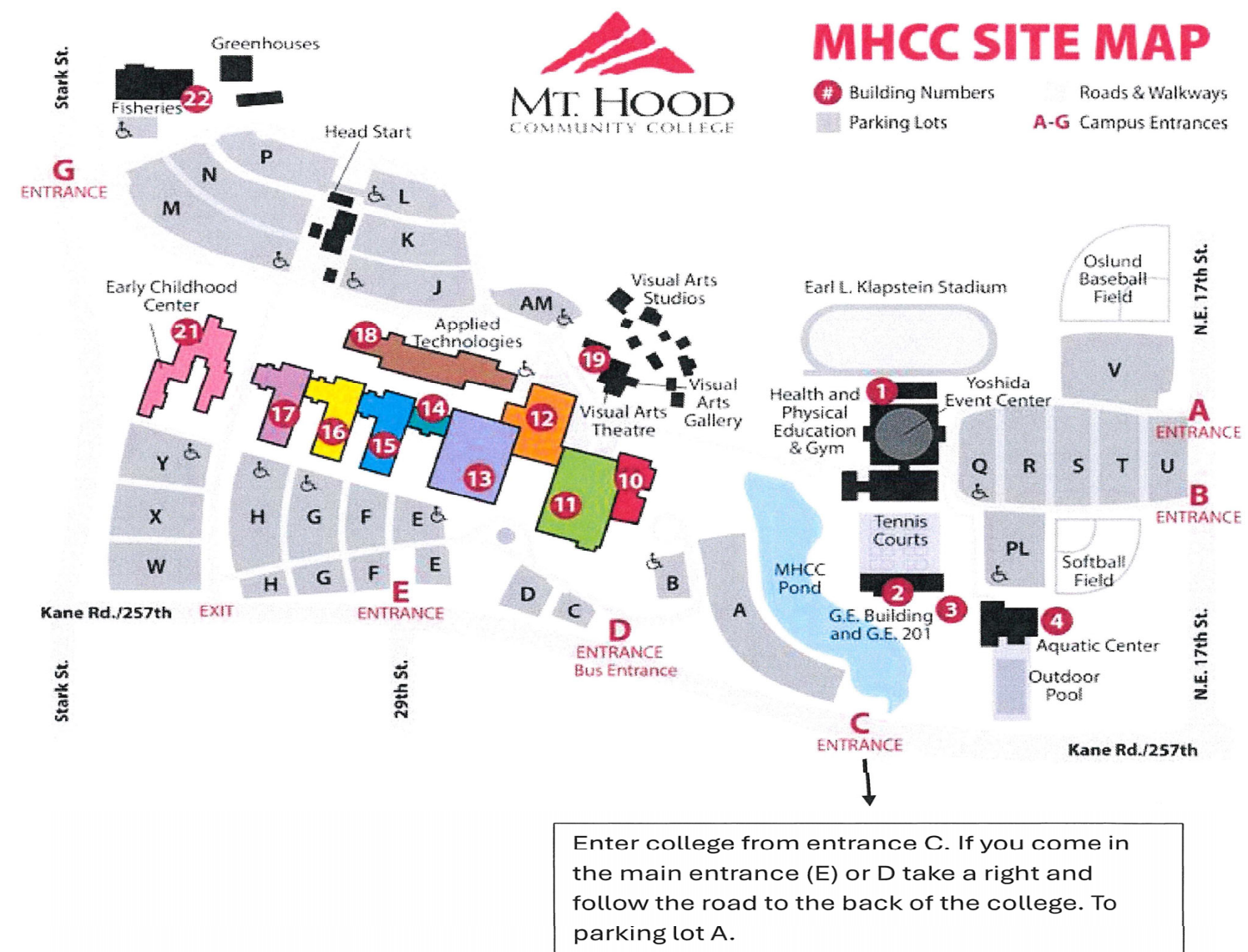
Zarephath Pantry

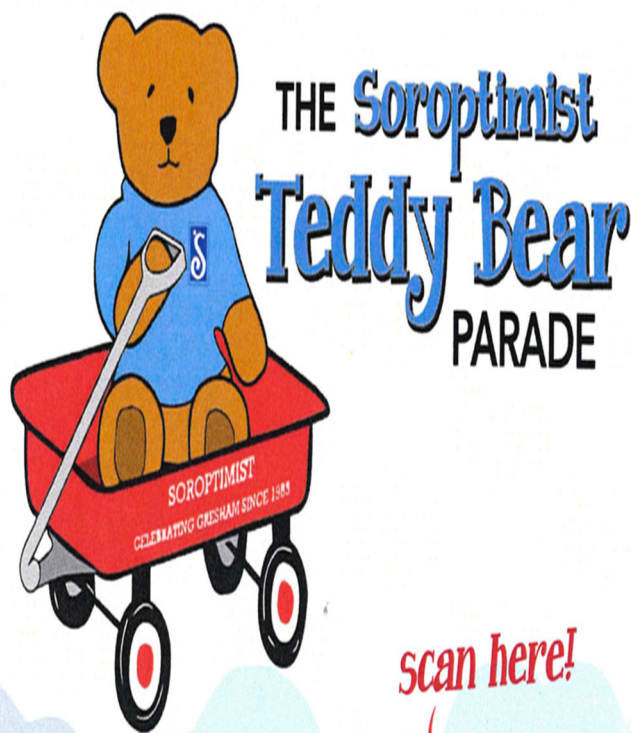
Apple of Your Eye

History of the land Trinity
Lutheran Sits on:

Dr Julius Sture, a local dentist, donated the land for the church sometime between 1928 and 1932. Dr Sture was also the organist and choir director for the church for over 40 years. His house is the same one that Zarephath Kitchen and Pantry is in now. All of the land that’s now part of Gresham is part of the homelands of the Cascades and Clackamas Chinook. This particular area has no permanent villages but was part of the seasonal round, which included hunting, huckleberry, blackberry picking and wapato harvest.

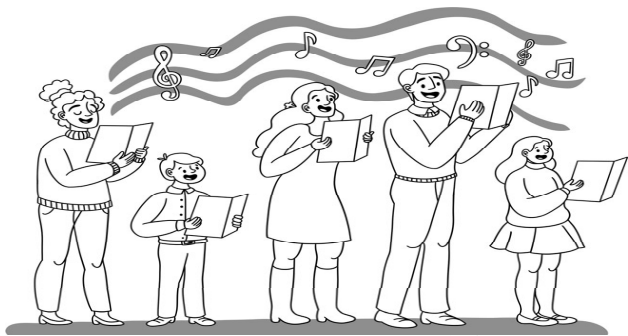
